- 436 Lord, make me a mountain

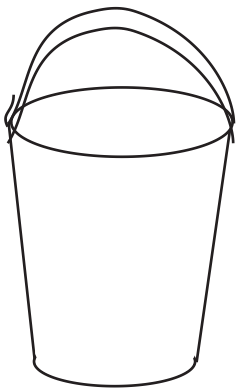
Bible Reading: **Luke 5: 1-11** Allocate Junior to prepare and read

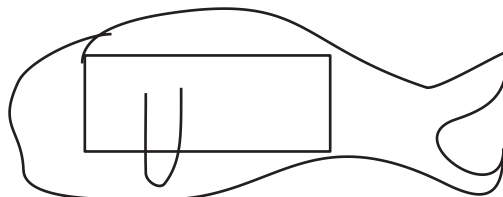
Chain Prayer: Allocate Junior to suggest three issues for prayer.

Fishing Quiz:

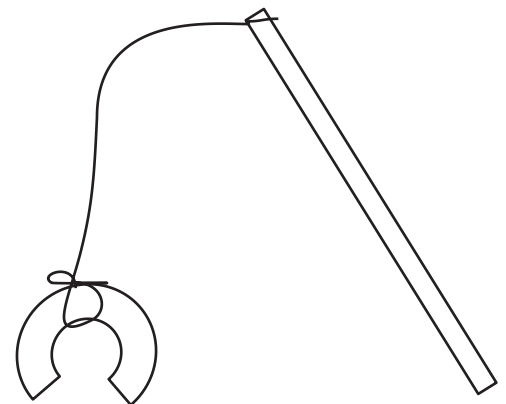
- Make copies of the fish onto thin card and cut out.
