

WHERE DO I GO FROM HERE?



It is hoped that having worked your way through the booklet you will realise there are many ways of “getting the message over”. There are no hard and fast rules. There is no average Group !

In the weekly programme, you can now develop further the things you have begun, e.g. Sword Drill can be for the whole Bible, methods of playing and scoring quizzes can be experimented with (T.V. programmes can give ideas), music can involve the Juniors playing their recorders and guitars.

Ideas for **Topics** can be found in the Junior Leader’s Manual. You can dip into that and select programmes and themes which are suitable for your Juniors. Seasonal and Christian Festivals can be explored also.

There are two topics in the Manual which go into much greater detail about the mechanics of Christian Endeavour. These will deepen your understanding of the Movement and also that of the Juniors. They are: “**CE History**” and “**CE Principles**”.

Each year a selection of verses is chosen for study for the Bible Examination. These passages can be learned through mime, quizzes and the Topic approach. The exam is then sat when your Group is ready for it. Each Junior can gain a certificate for the Award Scheme by doing this.

The Award Scheme is another aspect of Junior Christian Endeavour work. The Juniors can gain certificates and as they accumulate can be awarded with bronze, silver and gold badges. Full details of this Scheme is in the Junior Leader’s Manual.

Getting together with other Christian Endeavour Leaders is very important. There is a Leader’s Conference organised every year and a Leader’s Training session available. Try and get to this.

Remember that you are not alone as a Group. Once you are affiliated you can become part of your Christian Endeavour Union. The members of each Union can get together socially so that the Juniors can get to know each other and the Leaders can support each other in prayer and fellowship.

National events are organised for the Juniors annually. These include Junior Camp and special activities at the Annual Convention. The Juniors have an opportunity to get involved in these activities if you and your helpers take the lead.

Visit the website regularly and links for Christian Endeavour around the world. Your national Christian Endeavour Headquarters are always willing to assist you and so is the Junior Convener. Keep in touch!
